Introduction

This collection consists of the working files of Alice Eichholz in her capacity as genealogist and researcher in Vermont. The collection was given to the Vermont Historical Society by the Dr. Eichholz in December 2011. The collection is stored in ten document storage boxes and consumes ten linear feet of shelf space.

Biography

Alice Eichholz's career in higher education has included several positions focusing on continuing education. She is currently a member of the core faculty at Walden University (as of 2012). Previously, she had served as Academic Director of University Residencies at Walden and as Director of Lifelong Learning and Professor of Liberal Studies at Union Institute and University in Montpelier, Vermont. Before joining the Walden faculty, she had already worked with nontraditional students in higher and distance education both at Union Institute in Vermont and at Queens College in New York City. Her educational background includes a Ph.D. from New York University, an M.Ed. from Wayne State University, and undergraduate study at Indiana University.

Dr. Eichholz is also a professional researcher with over thirty-five years of experience in genealogical research. As a researcher and writer, her focus is on New England and multigenerational patterns in families. In 1993, she wrote the book, *Collecting Vermont Ancestors*, as a guidebook for budding genealogists and family historians into researching their ancestors in Vermont. She is a nationally recognized author of other books relating to the topic of family history. She also serves as a consultant for the Bowen Center for the Study of the Family.

Scope and Content Note

This collection includes the files of genealogist and family historian, Alice Eichholz, primarily in the 1980s and 1990s. These files document her work for genealogy clients. Individual files are organized by family name and comprised predominantly of correspondence, notes, print-outs from microfilm and other copies of historical documents. A full file listing of names is included in the inventory below.
