

Looking for something to do this afternoon?

- Have lunch on campus at Skinny Pancake, UVM Central Campus Dining Hall, or University

- Visit the **UVM Fleming Museum of Art**, 61 Colchester Avenue, an easy 10-minute walk from the Davis Center. See new installations for *The Fleming Reimagined: Confronting Institutional Racism and Historical Oppression* The staff at the Fleming Museum have been reckoning with how to become an anti-racist museum that's more responsive, relevant, and inclusive. Current special exhibits include *Josef Albers Formulation: Articulation, Art/Text/Context: From Artistic Practice to Meaning Making,* and *Dark Goddess: An Exploration of the Sacred Feminine.* Admission is **Free** from 12:00-4:00 on Saturdays. https://www.uvm.edu/fleming
- Thinking about your college plans? Learn about attending the University of Vermont by taking a self-guided walking tour of the campus: <u>link to tour</u>
- Explore UVM's campus and some historic places by going on the **UVM Historical Sites Scavenger Hunt**, thanks to the Center for Research on Vermont! All locations are within a ½ mile of the Davis Center. Learn about Andrew Harris and why there's a statue of the Marquis de Lafayette at UVM. Pick up a copy at the registration table or download a copy at https://vermonthistory.org/vhd-scavenger-hunt
- Visit the **UVM Howe Library**, an excellent research library. Exit the 1st floor of the Davis Center, heading north, and it's straight in front of you! Unfortunately, Special Collections at the Billings Library is closed on Saturdays, but come back another day to look at their primary sources.
- Check out the **Vermont History Day exhibits** in the Sugar Maple & Frank Livak Ballrooms between 2:00-3:00 pm. **Exhibits need to be broken down** and removed from the ballrooms between 3:00 and 3:30.
- Seen everything on campus? Catch the **College Street Shuttle** and head towards Church Street or the Waterfront. **Free!** Either catch the return shuttle or walk back up the hill. Shuttle stops at Waterman Building on S. Prospect. https://ridegmt.com/11-airport/ (Just make sure you take the Inbound schedule to the Waterfront and the Outbound schedule to UVM so you don't end up at the airport!)
- Remember to be back at 3:30 for a **group photo** in the Grand Maple Ballroom. And then stay for the **Awards Ceremony** at **3:45**.
