

VERMONT HISTORY TRIVIA

Do you know what a gore is, and how many of them in Vermont? How about the original name for Camel's Hump? What's the official state bird?

Test your wits while spending time with family and friends. You'll compete against other teams for prizes and learn fun new facts about the Green Mountain state.

The Vermont Trivia kit is available to historical societies, museums, libraries, and other cultural or nonprofit institutions to use for a fun, lighthearted program that can appeal to a range of audiences. The kit is available in multiple formats: all-digital, questions only or questions & prizes.

One round of the all-digital format is free for VHS institutional members (such as local historical societies or local libraries that subscribe to the VHS museum pass system) and additional rounds are available for a small fee. There are five rounds total available.

The kit includes questions and answers, guidelines for setting up and running the event, scorecards and a scoring system, and evaluation forms. Each round contains five rounds of eight questions, with a sixth round left blank for local questions of your own invention.
