

**Intervale Community Farm
Printed Materials, 1996-2020

Introduction

This collection consists of printed materials advertising the Intervale Community Farm in Burlington, Vermont, between 1996 and 2020. The collection was donated to the Vermont Historical Society by Sarah L. Dopp in 2023 and is housed in one archival flip-top box, consuming .25 linear feet of shelf space.

Administrative History

Burlington's Intervale is an 870-acre flood plain on the Burlington side of the Winooski River, where it flows through the cities of Burlington, Winooski, and Colchester. The Intervale Center operates as a nonprofit that owns, leases, and manages 350 acres in the Intervale, including subleasing land to the Intervale Community Farm and several other independently owned farms (as of 2024). The Intervale Community Farm was organized in 1990 as a member-owned, community-supported agriculture (CSA) farm with the goal of supplying the greater Burlington community with an affordable source of high-quality, organic produce. In 2024, their staff included five full-time, year-round employees, a part-time year-round bookkeeper/administrator, and several seasonal employees.

Scope and Content

The collection consists of newsletters, member guides, member communications, winter share forms, and other printed ephemera created by the Intervale Community Farm in Burlington, Vermont, and accumulated by Sarah L. Dopp (1946-2024) between 1996 and 2020. The newsletter, "Bottom Land News," included in the collection is an incomplete run (with some issues missing) from October 2001 until 2018. It transitions to an email newsletter around 2016 and is only collected through February 2018. Both email newsletters and other materials in the collection are addressed to Dopp and may reflect her involvement with the organization.
